1. OBJECT

- 1. To gain a general understanding of the science of homeopathy.
- 2. To decide if this is a practical delivery system of remedies in the healing of our dental patients (i.e. in our practice setting).

II. SUBJECT

1. Introduction A. History

Ancient Greece and Rome - first recorded use of remedies from herbal, flower and animal preparations.

Ancient Egypt - cited as the original source of the science of medicinal herbs.

Catalogues - were compiled on illnesses and conditions and the various herbs and preparations used for them.

B. Hahnemann: Originator of Modern Homeopathy

Author: "The Organon of Rational Medicine" <u>Cinchona bark</u> (South America) was used to relieve the symptoms of malaria.

Samuel Hahnemann, a German physician, expounding on the ancient concept of "like cures like", created a <u>diluted solution</u> of cinchona and made two impressive findings:

Hahnemann

- 1. The <u>diluted</u> solution of cinchona achieved a <u>more strikingly remarkable result</u> than the preparation in relieving symptoms of malaria.
- 2. When the cinchona <u>preparation</u> was administered to normal, healthy individuals, they developed fevers and profuse sweating as seen in malarial patients. When the <u>diluted solution</u> was given, the <u>side effects</u> did NOT appear.

C. The Concept of "Proving"

Hahnemann employed healthy medical students to consume large amounts of various potenised substances and then have them record their physical, emotional and mental reactions to the potency.

The technique of <u>pooling</u> information from various medicinal side effects is referred to as homeopathic "<u>proving</u>".

The "key note" symptoms are those which are most consistently and strongly felt by the majority of the testers.

D. The "Materia Medica"

The results of proving are collected and categorized in a text called the "Materia Medica"

For Example:

If a client presents with symptoms of a cold, those symptoms may be referenced.

ALLIUM CEPA

- 1. Watering and tearing of eyes
- 2. A runny nose (keynote symptoms)
- 3. Copious, clear nasal discharge

2. Creation of Homeopathic Remedy A. Preparation

1. water: alcohol solution (plus)

herb / plant

2. The solution (of water, alcohol and herb) is "ground up" (~ 100 times) to create the "mother tincture"

C. Potentization

If: 1c = 1 drop of mother tincture 99 drops of water

Then: 2c = 1 drop of 1c remedy 99 drops of water

(that is, 1/100th solution repeated 2 times)

D. Succussion

Review of the process:

Step 1: Create Mother Tincture

Step 2: Perform Serial Dilution

Eg 1C

Step 3: Succussion (ie "mixing")

i.e. the process of shaking and hitting a homeopathic remedy against a hard surface

Step 4: Potentization

Step 5: Succussion

(Et cetera)

E. Significance of Avagadro's Number

 $= 1 \times 10^{24}$

Dilutions at or above 24x or 12c (all M dilutions) have no physical substance left, that is, it is hypothesized that matter, in the form of molecules, does not exist.

However, instead of finding a loss of efficacy, it is increased.


3. The Mechanism of Action A. Vibrational Medicine?


Homeopathy is a form of what is called <u>vibrational medicine</u>, which itself is a form of energy medicine.

Definition: Vibration

A mechanical oscillation about a reference position which can be measured by <u>frequency</u>.

B. The Frequency of Matter

All matter, from stones to animals have frequencies or vibrations.

The vibrations can be broken down from whole body: system: organ: tissue: cell: organelle: enzyme: DNA

NOTE: The same cells or organs in different people will have the same frequency.

C. The Unique Properties of Water

H2O is bipolar - having both a positive and negative end. Since these occur on opposite ends, North and South Pole magnetism occurs.

Due to it's <u>polarity and magnetic nature</u>, water is thereby capable of carrying electromagnetic energy, i.e. <u>information</u> (eg CD's, DVD's)

Also because of it's EM properties, we (being 70% water) are <u>susceptible</u> to EM disturbances from TV's, computers, Earth and space (hence, the scientific basis for astrology?)

D. Homepathy: Vibrational Water?

The mechanism of action by which a homeopathic solution stores information (in the form of a cure, a virus or thought) is the imprinting of such information in the homeopathic solution which includes:

- 1. Creation of a Mother Tincture
- 2. Serial Dilution
- 3. Succussion
- 4. Potentization

A. The Allopathic Argument (cont)

Further, the <u>Law of Mass Action</u> stipulates that "once a solution is diluted beyond the point where any molecules are present, it cannot possibly have a pharmacological response."

B. The Paradox Explained Clearer Signals

The plant or mineral when first incorporated into a remedy, contains the proper healing frequency plus extraneous frequencies termed "noise".

Further dilutions "tune out" this noise in a fashion similar to tuning onto a radio station. Once the noise is eliminated, the healing sequence becomes clearer and stronger.



Clearer Signals at the Atomic Level

Dilutions less than 24x and 12c still have a molecular presence in water and therefore act on the molecular level.

Signals greater than 24x and 12c lacking a molecular presence therefore act on the atomic level.

C. The Scientific Proof

Jacques Benveniste published a paper (Nature, 1988) reporting that extreme dilutions of water solutions of an antibody still provoked an immunological response even after it was diluted beyond Avagadro's number.

He also noted agitation was necessary for this phenomenon to occur.

5. Schools of Thought

A. Classical Homeopathy

- · Original form outlined by Hahnemann
- · Treat one disorder with one remedy at a time
- · Dogmatic in approach and toleration
- Treat "constitutional" disorders i.e. considered the essential personality / typology of the patient:

sulphur silica (et cetera)
silica pulsatilla
phosphorus nux vomica
mercurius solubis pulsatilla

B. Complex Homeopathy

- Treat with many remedies at many different potencies at the same time
- generally less discipline and regimented in its approach
- greater use of nosodes (isopathy) rather than plant and mineral remedies (than the classical approach)
- approach is closer to allopathic ie treatment of symptoms
- dogma: if an incorrect remedy is prescribed, there should be no ill effect (based on Hahnemann's original finding that specific dilutions do NOT provoke symptoms or illness)

Overview of Schools

Classical Complex Philosophy: like cures like like cures like constitution Diagnosis: con./ symptoms one remedy/ many remedy/ Treatment: low (Hahn) low & many to high (Kent) potencies potency (specific) (non-specific) Remedies: plants / minerals nosodes

<u>6. The Biological Terrain and Pathophysiology</u> <u>1. The Mesenchyme</u>

- Comprises the Interstitial Fluid which functions as the solvent for dissolved nutrients for cellular uptake and likewise for exocytosis of cell wastes (i.e. homotoxins).
- Referred to as the cellular "Matrix" because it comprises the first line of defense buffer zone for cells to maintain health (homeostastis) and ward off dysfunction (i.e. disease)
- Stressors to the Matrix can be acquired or inherited:

H. Specificity

Nosodes can be given not only for the diseases they relate to but other (seemingly unrelated) conditions:

Nosode

Herpes

Arthritis, heart, nerves, pancreas

Syphilinum

Prostatitis, Breast cancer, Brain

III. APPLICATION

A. Examination and Diagnosis

Through a series of questions and prepared questionnaires, a homeopath will access:

- 1. Personality and temperament (emotional disposition)
- 2. Food Preferences (cravings, intolerances, likes, dislikes)
- 3. General Factors (affect by weather, season, time of day etc)
- 4. Fears (phobias and emotional issues such as fear of death, failure etc)

B. General Dispensing (Treatment)

Once the mother tincture is made, the remedy may be delivered in several fashions:

- 1. Remedy in distilled water
- 2. Pellets soaked in remedy
- 3. Salves and creams (skin)
- 4. Electromagnetic signatures

Pellets and drops are taken sublingually without food. Water may be taken before or 10 min. after.

C. Reversing A Remedy

During the healing period while a patient is on remedies, certain items should be avoided, which, if taken, will reverse the effects of the remedy.

- 1. Mint
- 2. Coffee and Tea (caffeine)
- 3. Chocolate
- (4. Allopathic drugs)

note: mint is found in most tooth pastes and mouth rinses

D. Drainage Strategies

In approaching a chronically poisoned and ill patient, the first approach is to lower the noise, that is, drain the congestion in the ISF Matrix.

Homeopathic agents are less effective when there are too many signals (i.e. many conditions simultaneously occurring) and loud signals (advanced disease). Drainage cleans out the Matrix and decreases the number and intensity of signals.

E. Detoxification Therapy

Once drainage is established in the ISF-Matrix, now the congestion causing factors such as heavy metals and chemical toxins can be addressed.

Nosodes (of the agents of causation) and Sarcodes (to direct Nosodes to the proper tissue) can now be utilized to direct the site and specificity of detoxification.

F. Emotional Therapy

Drainage and Detoxification procedures may be blocked by <u>emotional "toxins</u>".

Homeopathic preparations from <u>flowers</u> have been shown very effective in neutralizing these toxins.

The emotion of anger has been shown to suppress liver function and fear tends to impair kidney function.

The line of remedies utilized are called the "Bach Flower Remedies."

2. Dental Applications

A. Acute Episodes

- "Rescue Remedy" Bach Flower Remedy for acute emotional disturbances
- "Arnica" taken for pain
- "Traumeel" for dental pain and post-surgical

- 2. Elimination
- 3. Immune Stabilization

A1 - Cellular Recharge

Contents: cell salts

mitrochondrial sarcodes

- Decrease cell permeability to ISF - Matrix congested toxins

A2 - Gentle Drainage

<u>Contents</u>: organ sarcodes for liver, LI, kidney, and bladder

Effects:

- 1. Stimulate function of organs
- 2. Stimulate drainage of congested toxins

Indication: 1. All chemically sensitive patients

 To all patients who are generally reactive to allergens, food, medicines, remedies etc

A3 - Ultra-Antitox

Contents: Gem Remedies

sarcodes of lymph, CT & adipose

Effects: Stimulates drainage in the ISF-

Matrix to eliminate those toxins

released by the elimination organs

Indication: to eliminate and prevent the toxin

(ping-pong effect)

A4 - Deep Anti-tox

Contents: Gem Remedies

Sarcodes for intestine, liver and

spleen

Effects:

1. ISF-Matrix drainage

2. Elimination organ drainage

Indication: When other conditions such as

candida are present

Content: GH in dilution

Effect: Stimulate liver detoxification of

such as skin itchiness, nerve pain,

*Indication: for patients with heavy metal

sensitivity or allergies

A5 - Heavy Antitox

Content: Heavy metal nosodes

Effects: Targets the ISF-Matrix to drain heavy

metals

Contra-indications: The company indicates this product should not be used if mercury is present in the mouth. However, so few (if any) mercury nosodes are present that its use actually seems to strengthen patients

NOTE: must be used in conjunction with remedy D-5 Kidney Drainage

IV. CONCLUSIONS

Homeopathy offers itself as a valuable adjunct in chronic mercury toxicity. Its use in dentistry is very limited at this point and hence offers an avenue for further development for the interested student.

As to its efficacy - it should be stated the principal physicians for the Royal Family of England and John D. Rockefeller are Homeopathic Physicians.
